

A map is a representation of the Earth's features drawn on a flat surface. Maps use symbols and colours to represent features of an area, simplifying the real world.

## Features of a Map

Feature	Description
Title	Identifies the area shown, topic, focus or purpose of the map
Legend	Explains the meaning of symbols & colours
Scale	Represents the relationship between distance on the map and distance in the real world
Direction	Represented with an arrow or a symbol or by the use of latitude & longitude
Border	Sets the map apart from other information
Date of Publication	Indicates how recent the map is
